A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 12-63-01 and a new subsection to section 12-63-04(2) of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of reserve peace officer and powers of the peace officer standards and training board; and to amend and reenact section 12-63-02.3 of the North Dakota Century Code relating to reserve peace office licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 12-63-01 is created and enacted as follows:

"Reserve peace officer license" means a license issued to an individual

authorized by law or appointed by a criminal justice agency of this state on a

salaried or nonsalaried basis to enforce the law and to conduct or engage in

investigations of violations of the law within the scope of the reserve peace

officer's training.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 to section 12-63-02.3 is amended and reenacted as follows: 12-63-02.3. Reserve peace officer - License.

1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all provisions of this chapter apply to licensed reserve peace officers and a licensed reserve peace officer has the same authority as a licensed peace officer.

SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 12-63-04(2) of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows: Expend funds to sponsor training for instruction of licensees, to include up to

\$50,000 annually from fees collected by the board.

Motion
